



Special Education Services for Students and Parental Support

Bridgeway Academy provides support for guardians and students with specialized educational needs. It is our desire to help build positive, effective partnerships between the school community and home. Our goal is to help increase the knowledge of procedural safeguards and parent's rights for students receiving special education services and to provide students with one on one intervention support in order to meet or exceed the student's IEP goal(s).

Bridgeway Academy can assist **children** with special needs with the following:

- Assuring school programs and services meet state and federal requirements. This involves both compliance and technical assistance functions
- Identifying the student's learning style in order to build confidence as a learner and increase student success
- Evaluating the student's needs using informal observation checklists, student surveys and formative assessments
- Developing an academic plan including short and long term goals
- Providing intervention support including test-taking strategies that will close learning gaps and increase student achievement

Bridgeway Academy will serve as an Education Consultant for **guardians** of children with special needs. The services and support below are available upon request.

- BA will help parents understand the Procedural Safeguards of an IEP and parent's rights.
- BA will provide strategies to encourage and strengthen communication between guardians and school personnel.
- BA will serve as an advocate while attending special education school meetings with guardians.
- BA will listen to concerns of guardians about education issues involving their child with special needs and provide guidance accordingly.
- BA will work to establish a family-to-family support network that is specific to the child's disability.
- BA will direct parents to available community resources.
- BA will maintain and provide access to a library of articles, books, and videotapes on a wide range of special education topics such as ADHD, special education law, types of disabilities, support groups and recreational opportunities.
- BA will offer support to parents who are in need of special education consulting services in a confidential, supportive atmosphere.
