



Tutoring

Bridgeway Academy's tutoring program uses highly interactive lessons to keep students engaged and motivated. Our lessons incorporate fun educational activities that develop a student's natural curiosities, hold their interest and help build core skills. Our tutoring programs include help with study skills, so your child learns memorization skills, test taking strategies, organizational concepts, etc. We provide tutoring for students in grades K-12. Additionally, we can provide Pre-K tutors for students just starting out in school. Instruction is provided on your child's ability level. Our goal is to close the "learning gaps" and help your child be a confident and successful learner.

Bridgeway Academy's tutoring sessions are held in a nurturing environment that encourages students to ask for additional assistance and work through instructional problems at their own pace. Instead of a classroom full of students, tutoring is provided one-on-one or in a small group (5 to 7 students), so your child has a comfort level that only private tutoring can bring. We ensure your child receives individualized attention and maintains a focus on the areas of need.

Bridgeway Academy's tutoring services are offered after school on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday morning. Tutoring times are available upon requests.

Parental involvement is an integral part of any program. At **Bridgeway Academy**, we believe that it is critical to keep parents up-to-date with their child's progress. Our regular, detailed progress reports allow busy parents to see what the tutor and student are working on in their sessions as well as keep informed of what the tutor plans to cover in future tutoring sessions.

Bridgeway Academy tutors are qualified educators with a minimum of a four-year-college Bachelor's and are college-trained, many with extensive teaching experience. They undergo a verification of credentials with us, as well as background checks. Also, we employ teachers who have experience in educating children with learning disabilities such as ADD and ADHD.

NOTE: It is recommended that if your child has an Individualize Education Plan (IEP), a copy be submitted to the tutoring teacher. The IEP will be used for instructional purposed only. All information will remain confidential.
